**Level 6 Ski – To continue to refine all skills in varied snow conditions, speed and terrain**

**Level 1 Snowboard – To have good directional control while slide-slipping and traversing on both edges**

**Level 2 Snowboard – To link turns on green terrain**

**Level 3 Snowboard – To vary turn shape and adapt to uneven terrain**

**Level 4 Snowboard – To ride confidently on all blue runs in a variety of snow conditions and terrain**
